

The gloriously maverick music of Charles-Valentin Alkan (1813–88) is more familiar now than ever before. But even though his original compositions are now beginning to be heard, his equally individual transcriptions have not yet been systematically documented in recordings – an omission this series, which begins with Alkan's complete transcriptions of Mozart, seeks to redress.
