

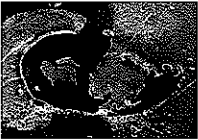

Beethoven's (1770-1827) deafness was already becoming apparent in 1798 – the same year that he began work on his 'Pathétique' Piano Sonata. Published in 1799, the sonata was dedicated to Prince Lichnowsky, who had travelled to Berlin with Mozart 10 years earlier. The singing *Adagio cantabile* is a striking contrast to the dramatic opening movement.
