Northern Winds is an inspirational album featuring a wealth of Canadian talent that highlights imaginative approaches to wind orchestration across various styles by several composers, from Louis Applebaum's *High Spirits* for full ensemble to Henry Kucharzyk's *Some Assembly Required* whose title wittily refers to his pointillistic/aleatoric technique. The young featured soloists have already been critically acclaimed, Canadian saxophonist Wallace Halladay as 'one of Canada's leading performers of contemporary music' and Australian-born, Halifax-based pianist Simon Docking for his 'extraordinarily vivid realizations of contemporary music'.
