The impact of Russian and Oriental culture on Rayel's formative years retained a hold on him throughout his life. His colourfully re-orchestrated selections from Rimsky-Korsakoy's symphonic suite 'Antar' and opera Mada, with interpolations of his own music, as the incidental score for a theatre production are heard here in their première recording, revived and reconstructed alongside a new text that symbolizes the romance and chivalric spirit of Antar the warrior-poet and his beloved Abla, Rayel's fascination with the exotic is brought together with Debussy's influence in the rayishing and enduringly popular song cycle Shéhérazade.
